Following on from the introduction of Victoria's stage 3 restrictions, Victorian Premier Daniel Andrews yesterday announced further restrictive measures and announced a move to stage 4 restrictions.

1. businesses that will remain open;
2. industries and sectors that will need to close for the next six-week period; and
3. businesses that will remain open but will operate at significantly reduced capacity.
